Delta Sigma Theta Sorority, Inc. (DST) is a private, nonprofit organization whose purpose is to provide assistance and support through established programs in local communities throughout the world. The Wilmington (DE) Alumnae Chapter (WAC) of DST was chartered on March 6, 1949 by ten Deltas in Wilmington to address social needs in New Castle County, Delaware.

Delta Outreach and Education Center, Inc. (DOEC), is a collaborative community outreach organization established in 1993 by WAC. Its purpose is to provide a broader range of outreach programs in the Greater Wilmington area. DOEC is a tax-exempt nonprofit organization, per section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code.

In accordance with shared goals, WAC and DOEC are pleased to offer a combined total of \$10,000 in scholarship assistance. Funds will be awarded to qualified African American seniors who reside in and attend high school in New Castle County, Delaware and plan to attend a four year, degree granting college or university in the fall of 2017.

Applicants will be judged on the basis of:

1. financial need;
2. scholastic record (official transcript);
3. extracurricular activities;
4. letters of reference; and
5. writing samples (see application).

All materials must be **postmarked** and mailed to the address listed on the application by **April 14, 2017**. Scholarship winners will be contacted by no later than May 1, 2017 and should be prepared to attend the WAC youth awards activity on Sunday, May 7, 2017; more details will provided to the winners at the time of notification.
